



CLOSURE TO HAMILTON BERTHS NO: 2 & 3

Please be advised that the wharfs at Hamilton No 2 and 3 are now closed to all vessels with immediate affect.

No vessels will be able to moor at these berths, which are no longer fit for purpose and have been decommissioned. These wharves are no longer viable for lay-up vessels or cargo operations.

Depths alongside these facilities will be maintained at 9.00mtrs LAT as the berth pockets form part of the Hamilton Swing Basin.

The Port of Brisbane will continue to operate the common user facilities at Pinkenba Bulk Berth, and the new General Purpose Berth at Fisherman Islands.

Maritime No 1 (Wet Bulk Berth) will continue to be operated by the Port of Brisbane Corporation. Maritime No 2 is only used by Bunker Vessels, and will close later in 2010. Portside will continue to operate the Cruise Wharf and Hamilton No 1 as part of their 360mtrs of quayline, and P&OAGS will continue operations at Hamilton No 4.
