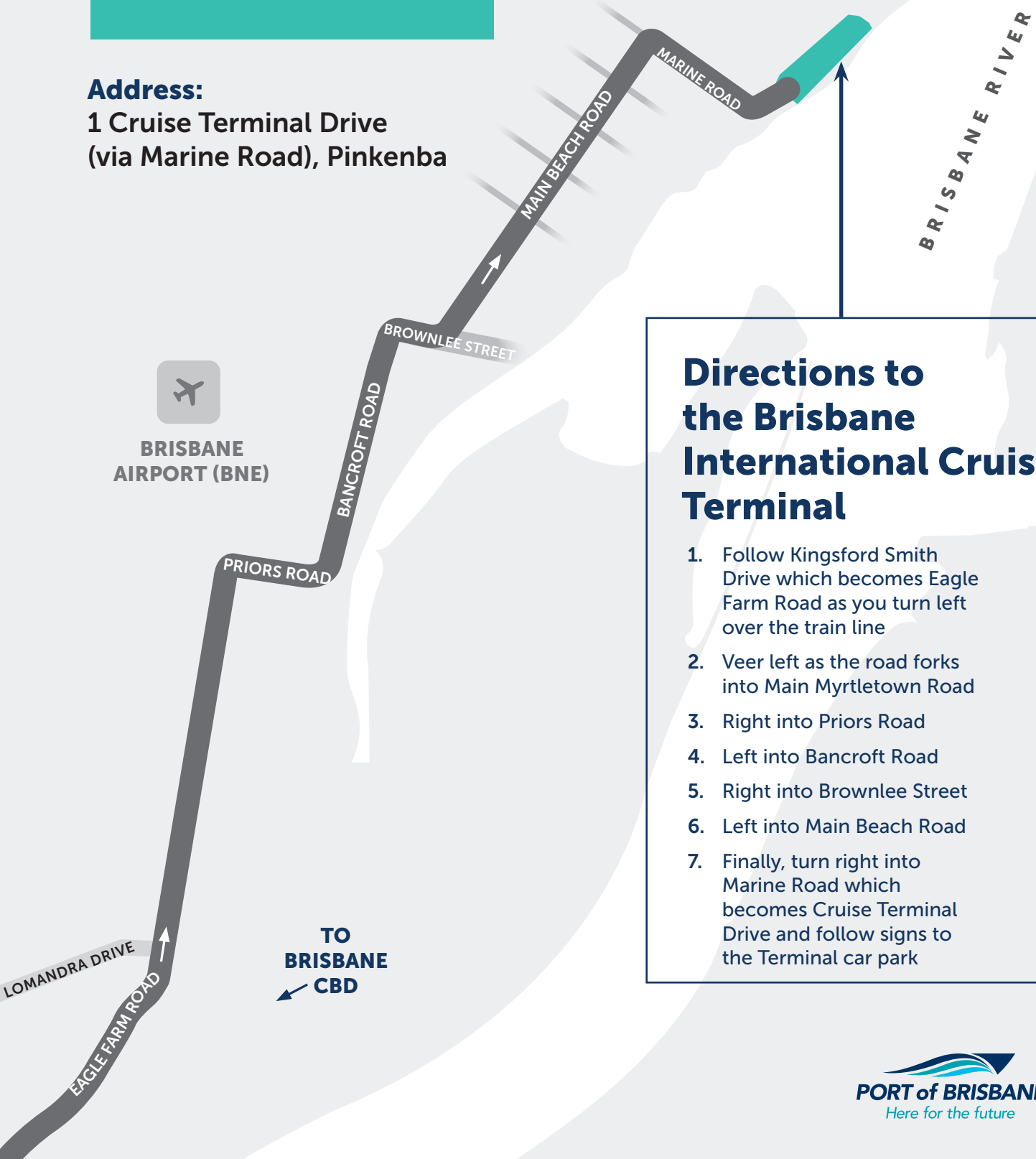
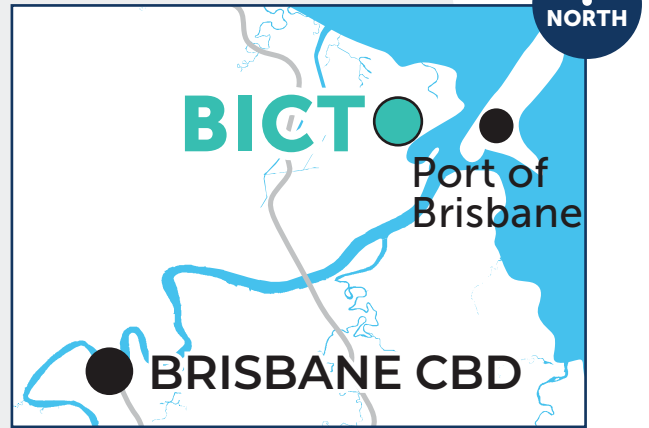


Brisbane International Cruise Terminal

1 Cruise Terminal Drive
(via Marine Road), Pinkenba



Directions to the Brisbane International Cruise Terminal

1. Follow Kingsford Smith Drive which becomes Eagle Farm Road as you turn left over the train line
2. Veer left as the road forks into Main Myrtletown Road
3. Right into Priors Road
4. Left into Bancroft Road
5. Right into Brownlee Street
6. Left into Main Beach Road
7. Finally, turn right into Marine Road which becomes Cruise Terminal Drive and follow signs to the Terminal car park

Getting to the Brisbane International Cruise Terminal

The Brisbane International Cruise Terminal is Brisbane's new home for cruising.

Located in Pinkenba at the mouth of the Brisbane River, it is close to Brisbane Airport with easy access to South East Queensland's major tourist regions including the Gold and Sunshine Coasts and Brisbane's CBD.

Terminal overview

The Terminal is located at Pinkenba (also known as "Luggage Point") on the north bank of the Brisbane River. It comprises:

- a two-level terminal building that includes a café and light retail
- on-site paid car parking for around 900 cars
- access for coaches, taxis and rideshare
- luggage collection and drop-off areas
- designated arrivals, check-in, security and quarantine areas
- public open spaces, including a plaza area and waterfront promenade.

Services and amenities

The following services and amenities are located at the terminal:

- male/female and accessible toilets
- parents room
- drinking fountain
- designated smoking area.



Getting here

The Brisbane International Cruise Terminal's address is 1 Cruise Terminal Drive, Pinkenba. Turn right onto Marine Road which becomes Cruise Terminal Drive.

Please note, some GPS' may not yet recognise the new street in their systems. If this is the case, use Marine Road, Pinkenba, as the location and follow the road signage to the cruise terminal.



From the south

From the Gateway Motorway, cross the Sir Leo Hielscher Bridges and take exits 105 or 106, then turn right onto Kingsford Smith Drive. Continue east towards Pinkenba and follow the signs to the terminal.



From the north

From the Gateway Motorway, take Southern Cross Way and follow the signs towards Kingsford Smith Drive. Continue east towards Pinkenba and follow the signs to the terminal.



From the CBD and west

The BICT is approximately 30-35 minutes (20km) from the CBD. Follow Kingsford Smith Drive past Hamilton. Continue east towards Pinkenba and follow the signs to the terminal.



From Brisbane Airport

Turn into Lomandra Drive then left onto Main Myrtletown Road. Follow the signs to the terminal. If you are travelling from Brisbane Airport, allow approximately 15-20 minutes.

Public transport

The cruise terminal is not serviced by public transport, however you can arrive by private vehicle, taxi or rideshare.
