PORT NOTICE Controlled Activities and Overside Maintenance

Take notice that controlled activities and overside maintenance undertaken in relation to a ship within the port limits are regulated by this Port Notice.

- A person must not undertake a controlled activity or overside maintenance, in relation to a ship in the port limits, without the prior written approval of the Port of Brisbane Pty Ltd (the Company).
- 2. A person must only undertake a controlled activity or overside maintenance in accordance with the conditions (if any) of the written approval granted by the Company.
- 3. In this Port Notice:
 - a) 'controlled activity' means, in relation to a ship, burning, welding, riveting, spray painting or sand blasting
 - b) 'overside maintenance' means, in relation to a ship, painting (other than spray painting), chipping, sanding (other than sand blasting), grinding or scraping of the ship's hull or overside fittings
 - c) 'port limits' means the port limits of the Port of Brisbane as defined by the *Transport Infrastructure (Ports) Regulation 2005* (Qld).

Failure to comply with this port notice is an offence against the *Transport Infrastructure Act* 1994

Maximum Penalty - 100 Penalty Units Per Offence
