## Chartered connections at the Brisbane International Cruise Terminal

The Brisbane International Cruise Terminal (BICT) is Brisbane's new home for cruising.

The Multi-User Terminal at Port of Brisbane (Fisherman Island) is now CLOSED to cruise ship calls.

### Address

- **1 Cruise Terminal Drive, Pinkenba 4008.**
- Some GPS systems may not recognise the new road. If that is the case, use **Marine Road, Pinkenba** and follow the signs.

### Opening days

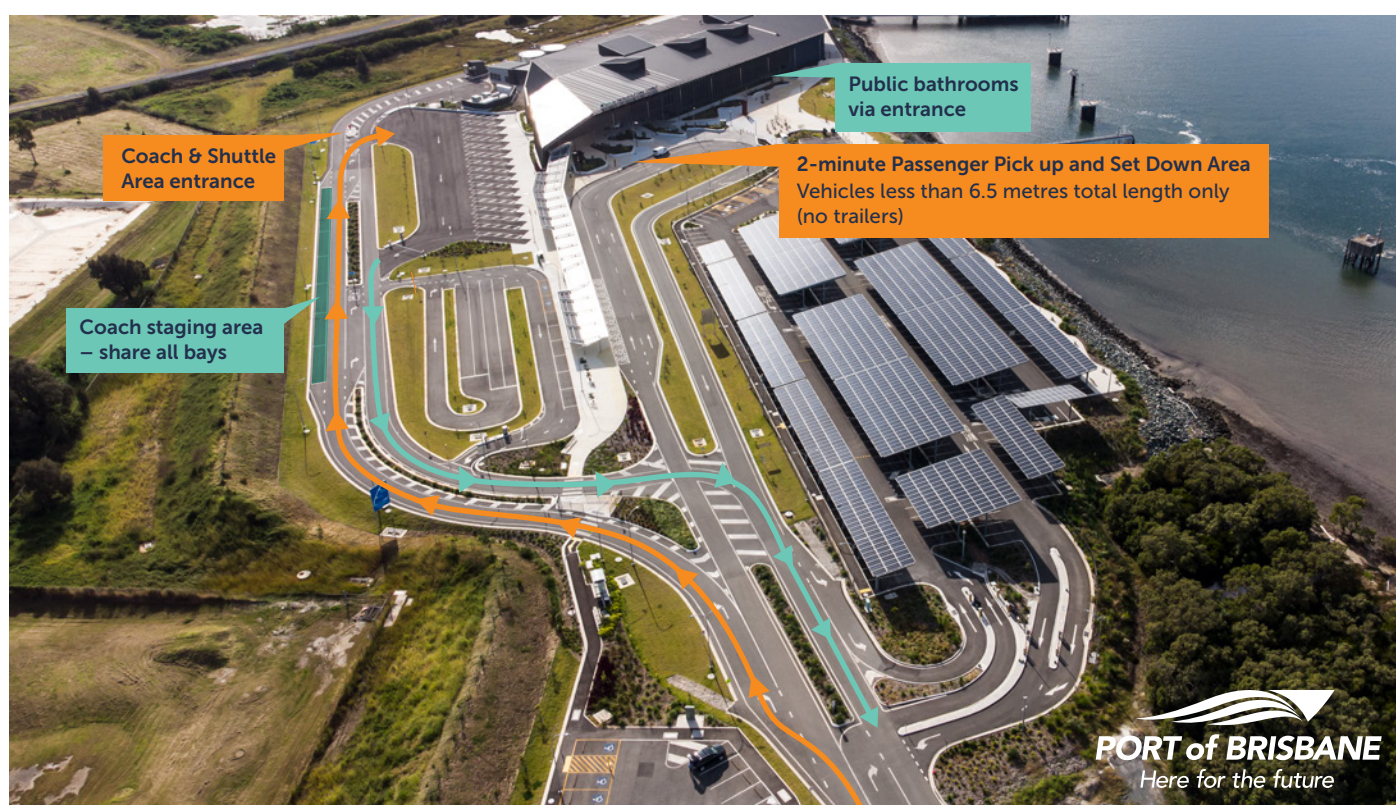
- The cruise terminal is only open to the public on cruise ship days – please refer to the Cruise Ship Schedule on our website.

### Access to the BICT

- Only coaches / buses which are pre-booked by the cruise lines operating from the terminal that day are permitted to access the BICT site.
- Offsite car parking shuttle operators or chartered connections seeking to transfer passengers to/from the BICT must seek prior agreement from Port of Brisbane Pty Ltd (PBPL).
- Contact PBPL to discuss site access further.

### Coach & Shuttle Area – parking

- **All coaches, chartered connections, offsite parking shuttles and vehicles longer than 6.5 metres must park in the Coach & Shuttle Area.** Follow the road signage to the Coach & Shuttle Area as shown on the map.
- Vehicles longer than 6.5 metres – including coaches chartered coaches/buses, parking shuttles or any vehicle with a trailer – **are not permitted** in the 2-minute Passenger Pick up and Set Down Area at the front of the terminal building.







- Limousines larger than 6.5 metres or with trailers must only use the Coach & Shuttle Area, and only with prior permission from PBPL/Wilson Parking.
- Limousines less than 6.5 metres total length may use the 2-minute passenger drop off loop and the driver must remain with the vehicle at all times.

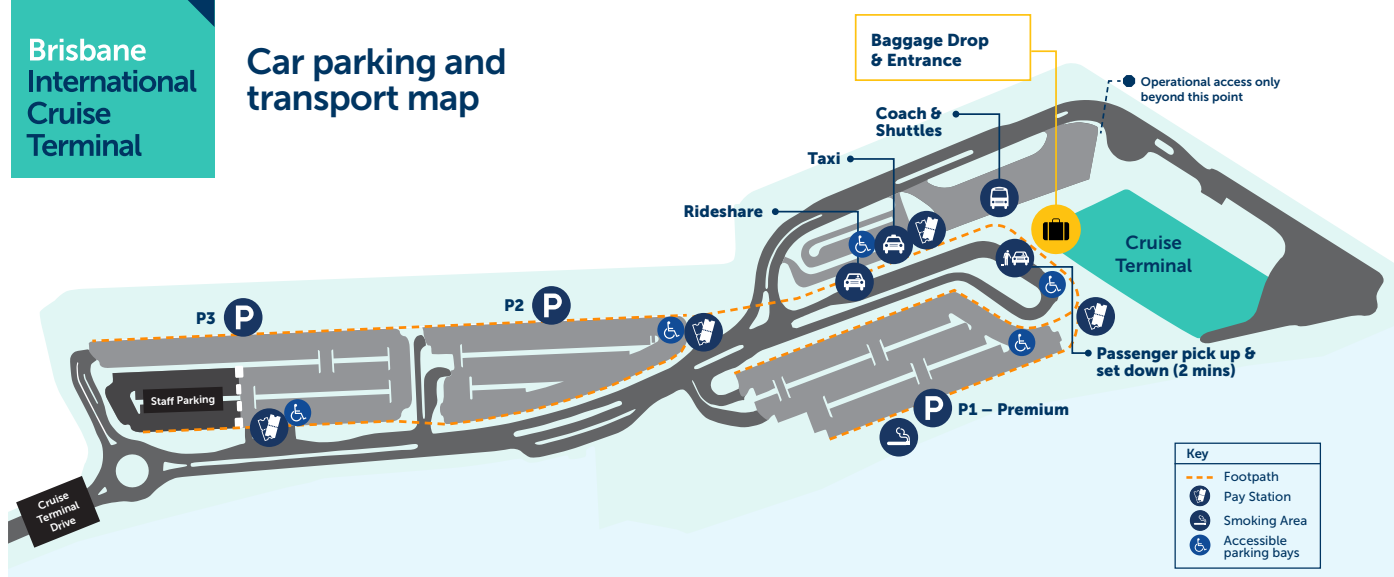

## Car parking and transport map



### P1 – Premium

- Most car parking under shade structures (not enclosed)
- Accessible parking (open air parking; closest to terminal building)
- Exit boom gates accept Master and Visa card only
- Electric vehicle charging station and parking bays
- No vehicles with trailers
- Approx. 50 metres to 220 metres to building entrance

### P2

- Open air car parking
- Accessible parking
- Exit boom gates accept Master and Visa card only
- No vehicles with trailers
- Approx. 250 metres to 390 metres to building entrance

### P3

- Open air car parking
- Accessible parking
- Staff car parking
- Exit boom gates accept Master and Visa card only
- No vehicles with trailers
- Approx. 420 metres to 575 metres to building entrance

### Passenger pick up & set down

- Maximum 2 minutes passenger pick up & set down:
- Private vehicles only
- Accessible pick up & set down bays
- Driver to remain in vehicle
- No vehicles with trailers
- Approx. 40 metres to building entrance

### Taxi

- Undercover walkway
- Accessible taxi bays
- Approx. 120 metres to building entrance

### Rideshare

- Undercover walkway
- Approx. 120 metres to building entrance

### Coach & Shuttles

- Offsite car park or chartered connections
- Bus services and tour groups
- Airport shuttle bus transfers
- Pick up & set down
- Approx. 40 metres to building entrance
