

PORT NOTICE

Restriction on Movement of Persons

TAKE NOTICE that a person other than an Authorised Person must not walk on:

- a) a Prescribed Road
- b) the shoulder of a Prescribed Road

unless:

- c) directed to do so by an authorised officer of the Port of Brisbane Pty Ltd or the Queensland Police Service
- d) an emergency necessitates walking on a Prescribed Road or the shoulder of a Prescribed Road.

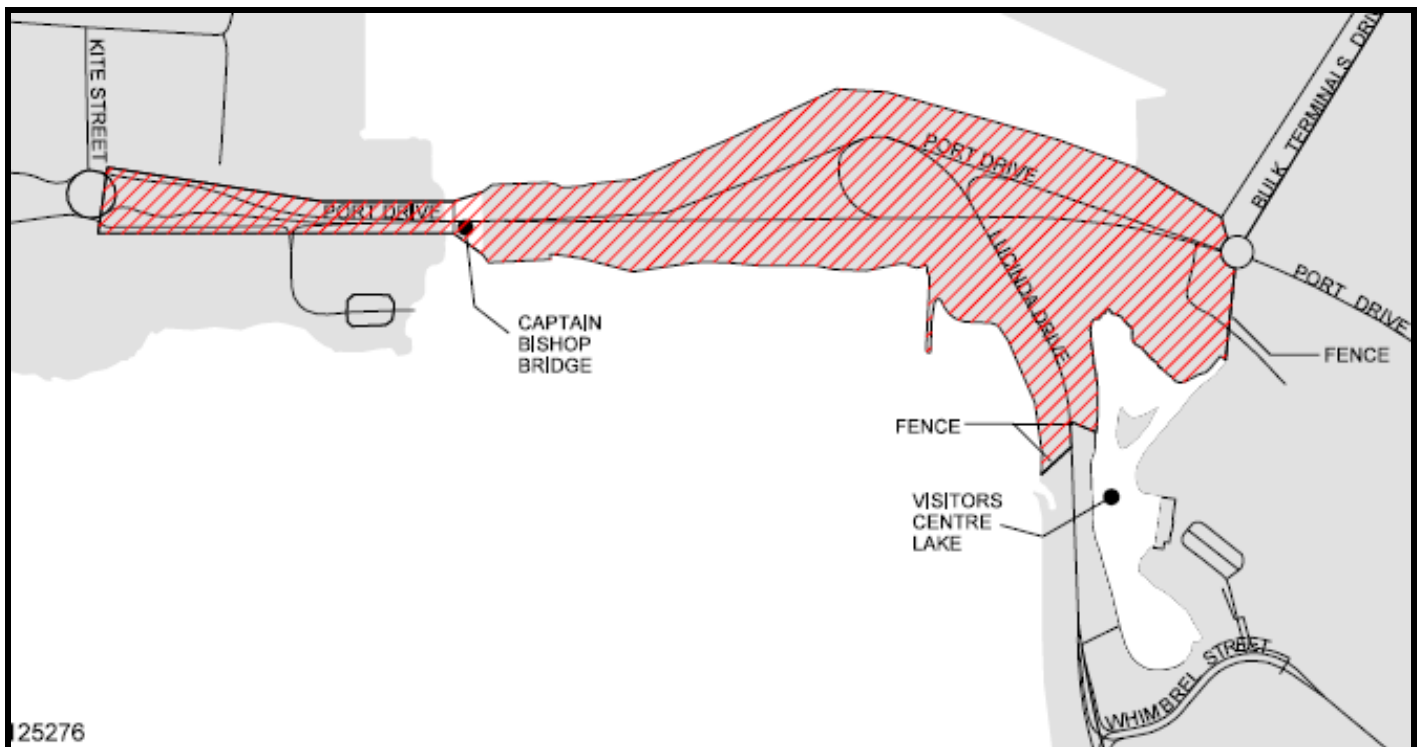
In this Port Notice, the following definitions apply:

Authorised Person means:

- a) an employee of Port of Brisbane Pty Ltd
- b) a person otherwise authorised by Port of Brisbane Pty Ltd to walk on a Prescribed Road or the shoulder of a Prescribed Road.

Prescribed Road means:

- a) Port Drive from Kite Street to Bulk Terminals Drive
- b) Lucinda Drive from Port Drive to Whimbrel Street intersection (depicted in the map below)



Failure to comply with this Port Notice is an offence under the *Transport Infrastructure Act 1994*.

MAXIMUM PENALTY - 25 Penalty Units Per Offence
